Born in Croatia in 1973, Marica Bodrožić moved to Germany as a child. She studied cultural anthropology, psychology and Slavonic Studies in Frankfurt a.M., and now lives in Berlin. Her first publication, *Tito ist tot*, received the Hermann Lenz Grant, the Heimito von Doderer and the Adalbert vom Chamisso Most Promising Young Writer Awards. Most recently this spring, she was awarded the 2011 Liechtenstein-Literaturpreis.
