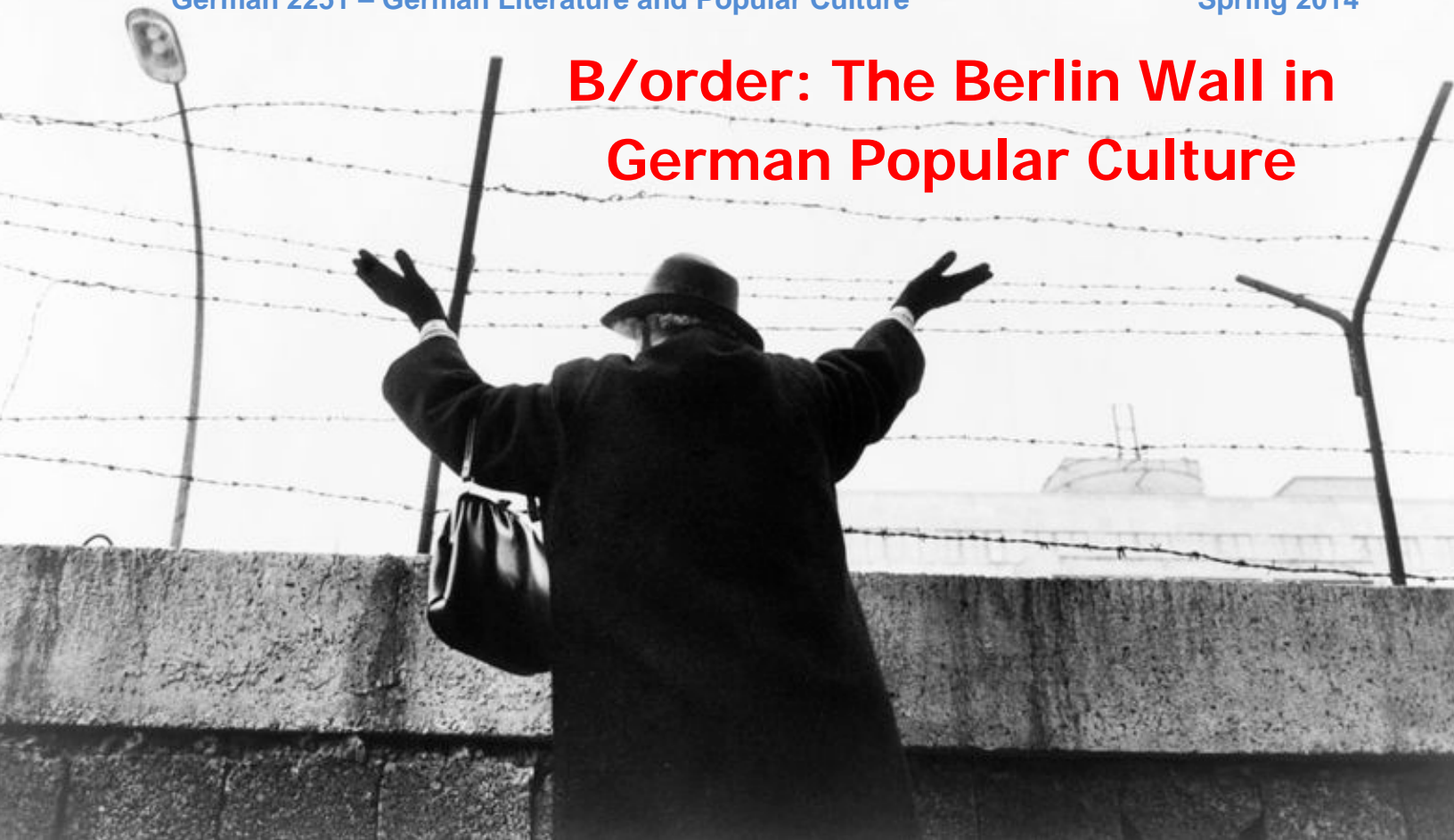


B/order: The Berlin Wall in German Popular Culture



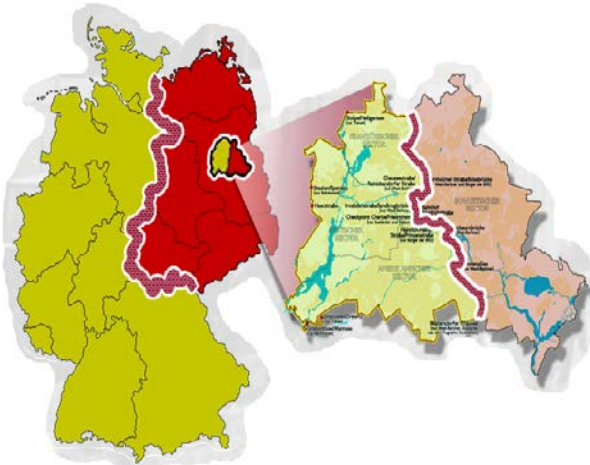
